

12 LIFESAVING RULES

Life Saving Rules were developed following a review of serious injuries and high potential incidents that have occurred in the business. These rules must be complied with at all times.

They underline our commitment to safety and aim to ensure lives are protected. If you have any questions, speak to your supervisor or a member of the HSE team.



1. Working at Heights

I will never work 1.8 meters or above if I am not secured with a double land-yard lifeline.



2. Suspended Loads

I will never work or walk under a suspended load.



3. Isolation, Lockout and Electrical Safety

I will always ensure that I have isolated and locked out before working on moving machinery and electrical equipment.



4. License to Operate and Permit to Work

I will only operate equipment that I am licensed for and always observe permit to work conditions and requirements.



5. High Wall Safety

I will never work, walk or park closer than 5 meters from a high wall in the pit.



6. HIRA

(Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment) - I will never start doing work without completing a risk assessment.



7. Stop Unsafe Work and Fit for Work

I will always stop work when my life is threatened, and I will always be fit for work.



8. Vehicle Driving and Trackless Equipment

I will always maintain positive contact with trackless equipment and have a license to drive.



9. Barricading

I will never enter barricaded areas unless authorized.



10. Confined Space

I will always obtain authorization to enter a confined space.



11. Smoking

I will not smoke outside designated smoking areas.



12. Cellular Mobile Use

I will never use a handheld or hands-free phone or mobile device while driving or in the plant.
